WHAT DOES THIS AMENDMENT MEAN TO YOUR DISTRICT

THE AMENDMENT WILL HAVE A PROFOUNDLY NEGATIVE IMPACT ON THE COMMUNITIES IN YOUR DISTRICT

PERMIT DOCUMENTS FOR STANDARDS AND QUALITY OF LIFE PROTECTIONS FOR NEIGHBORS TO MITIGATE THE IMPACT OF BARS AND LIVE ENTERTAINMENT VENUES IN NEIGHBORHOODS ARE ELIMINATED FROM THE CZO

- **A NOISE ABATEMENT PLAN, A SECURITY PLAN, AN OPERATIONAL PLAN, AN OCCUPANCY PLAN, HOURS OF OPERATION, A SANITATION PLAN, AND A SUMMARY OF THE NUMBER OF CHURCHES, SCHOOLS, PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS WITHIN 300 FT OF A PROPOSED VENUE, AND IF EXPANDING NEW PLANS FOR THE ABOVE ITEMS.**
- **ELIMINATED FROM THE CZO IS THE REQUIREMENT FOR CLOSED WINDOWS AND DOORS FOR BARS AND VENUES WITH LIVE ENTERTAINMENT AND THE REQUIRED COMPLIANCE WITH THE CITY NOISE ORDINANCE. IT IS REPLACED WITH LANGUAGE TO PERMIT RECORDED SOUND IN COURTYARDS IN THE VIEUX CARRE**
- **PERMITS HOLDING BARS THAT CAN MORPH INTO NIGHT CLUBS**
- ❖ **THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDED, IF REMOVED FROM THE CZO, STANDARDS FOR NEIGHBORHOOD PROTECTIONS AND PERMIT REQUIREMENTS BE RETAINED BY ORDINANCE IN CHAPTER 66 OF THE CITY CODE FOR THE NOISE ABATEMENT PLAN AND THE REMAINDER TO CHAPTER 10 OF THE CITY CODE. IT RECOMMENDED DENIAL OF OPEN DOORS AND WINDOWS AND MUSIC IN COURTYARDS IN VIEUX CARRE**
- ❖ **THERE WAS NO LEGAL MAJORITY ON THE VOTE AND IT WENT TO CITY COUNCIL WITH NO RECOMMENDATION**
